

Do's and Don'ts for new Kia owners

Filling up with gas: Stop filling the tank after the fuel nozzle automatically

clicks off. Do not try to 'top up' the tank. Leave some room for the fuel to expand with temperature changes. If you don't, the malfunction indicator lamp may come on.

Gas cap: Screw the fuel fill cap back on until it clicks at least three

times. If you do not properly tighten the cap, the malfunction

indicator lamp may come on.

Radio code: Record your radio code in a safe place at home. You will

need it to reactivate the radio if the power is cut off (eg: battery goes dead or is replaced). At times, a battery must be disconnected while the vehicle is in for service.

Manuals: Don't forget to read your owner's manual and keep it in

your vehicle for quick reference.
